674th

Monday Jan 8th/71

This day commenced the same at 2 o'clock finished boiling & put on the fat. Spoke & gammoned the Bk. Euston saw another Bk to the windward at sundown shortened sail as usual Broke & Meid part fine weather Latter part light breeze from the S.W. steering to the N.W. under all sail Bk & B. Phillips & Euston on sight made all sail

675th

Tuesday Jan 9th/71

This day began the same at sundown shortened sail as usual Meid part fine weather Latter part light breeze from the S.W. out a cask steering by the wind under all sail 1 sail in of Pork light broke out a cask of oil to cooper from the fore hold

676th

Wednesday Jan 10th/71

This day commenced the same coopered the oil ready for steaming. at 3 o'clock spoke the B. Phillips and gammoned at sundown shortened sail as usual Meid part fine weather one ship at 2 o'clock heading S Latter part steering by the wind under all sail slowed down the oil which was about 13 bbls flying jib stay parted

677th

Thursday Jan 11th/71

This day commenced the same spliced the stay & set it up ship heading to the S.E. saw 12 sail at sundown shortened sail as usual Latter caught part calm sent down the main sail & a shark repaired it - saw a sail

This day commenced the same but the main sail at sundown shortened sail Meid part fine weather Latter part rain for the steepers steering E. with a fresh breeze from the N.W.

679th

Saturday Jan 13th/71

This day commenced with a fresh breeze from the N.W. steering the same rose over wheel rope at sundown shortened sail as usual & luffed to on the Starboard tack Meid part the same Latter part fresh breeze from the S.W. at 6 o'clock made all sail steering E.S.E. at 10 o'clock spoke the Bk Ospray Capt. Keyer of New Bedford 32 months out with \$15.00 bbl oil

680th

Sunday Jan 14th/71

This day commenced the same gammoning with the Ospray at sundown shortened sail as usual & luffed to the Port tack at 8 1/2 o'clock parted from the said Bk had the Starboard Bk move along side Meid part moderate one ship at 1 1/2 o'clock Latter part steering E.S.E. under all sail with a fresh breeze from the N.W. Ospray on sight

Monday Jan 15th/71

This day commenced with a moderate breeze from the N.W. steering E.S.E. under all sail at sundown shortened sail Meid part steering by the wind on the Port tack Latter part fresh breeze from the N.W. steering N.W. the S.E. under all sail spoke & gammoned the Bk Vigilant of N.B. 3 months out with 2000
