715th

Sat - Feb 18th

This day commence with a fresh breeze from the S. & W. ship heading W. under all sail on the Port tack. Saw Cow fish & Albicoree (caught a large Albicoree at sundown took in the light sail & double reefed the topsails. Mid part heading W. S. W. Latter part steering S. W. under all sail on the Port tack saw porpoises

716th

Sun Feb 19th / 71

This day begins with a fresh breeze from the Southward steering N. W. under top sails & courses. Saw Cow fish & Albicoree at sundown double reefed hauled the main sail up & down ship. Mid part steering by the wind under double reefed top sails & fore sail. Latter part light breeze from the Southward steering to the N. & W. under all sail

Nothing in sight

717th

Mon Feb 20th

This day commence the same at sundown shortened sail as usual. Mid part light breeze. Latter part fresh breeze from the S. Made all sail steering by the wind on the Port tack. Watch employed in stripping the dry work & saw confused

718th

Tues Feb 21st

This day commence the same saw Cow fish. at sundown shortened sail. Mid part moderate. Latter part light breeze from the S. steering by the wind under all sail on the Port tack. nothing in sight

719th

Wednesday Feb 22nd / 71

This day commence with a light breeze from the S. steering by the wind under all sail at sundown shortened sail as usual. Mid part fine weather. Latter part light breeze from the Southward ship heading W. S. W. under all sail on the Port tack sent down & repaired fore top gallant sail

720th

Thursday Feb 23rd

This day commence the same employed in repairing the Ensign at sundown took in the top & sails. Mid part squally took in the light sails & hauled the main sail up. Latter part fresh breeze from the Southward steering by the wind under all sail saw porpoises. Lat 16.04.

721st

Friday Feb 24th

This day commence the same at sundown took in the light sails. Mid part squally. Latter part fresh breeze from the S. E. steering W. under top sails course. Jib & sparker broke out. Lat 16.48.

Sat Feb 25th

This day commence the same saw porpoises at sundown double reefed the top sails. Mid part the same. Latter part fresh breeze from the S. E. steering West under all sail finished the mast for the main top
