

Remarks on Board Alb. Globe

723rd

Sun Feb 26th

This day commences with a light breeze from the S.E. Steering West under all sail at 10 o'clock raised a school of sperm whale a point off the lee bow at 1 1/2 o'clock launched 3 Boats and gave chase at 3 1/2 o'clock the Bow Boat struck a 30 bl whale the Starboard Boat pulled up to the whale and shot a Bomb lance into him killing him instantly. The Capt. lowered the whale near the ship the Main Boat & Starboard Boat gave chase to more whales the Main Boat went along side of a large whale but did not succeed in striking. at 5 1/2 o'clock took whale along side. the 3 Boats returned at sundown took in the light sail & double reefed & furled the main sail. Mid part lay in with head yards aback set on track & going. Latter part fresh breeze from the S.E. accompanied with rain & squall at 6 1/2 o'clock commenced cutting.

Mon Feb 27th

This day commences the same at 7 o'clock had the Bridg sent in for dinner and hooked on to the case & jib & took at 3 o'clock had it in on deck all hands employed in clearing away the head. Traced forward on the Starboard Deck over the fore sail & fore top sail. Mid part put on watch employed in clearing away the jam & getting ready to start the works started the works at 3 o'clock biling on the Head

From Fish Bay towards St. Helena Latter part strong breeze from the S. accompanied with rain & squall. Watch employed in biling. Saw porpoise. Tues Feb 28th

725th

This day commences with a fresh breeze from the South accompanied with rain & squall steering by the wind under double reefed top sail fore sail jib & spanker finished biling the Head turned up the 6th at sundown took in the light sail. Mid part squally moderate breeze steering by the wind under double reefed top sail fore sail jib spanker up 3 o'clock got up sail finished biling at 10 o'clock & put on the far lean

726th

Wednes March 1st

This day commences the same at sundown shortened sail Mid part squally Latter part fresh breeze from the S.E. steering by the wind under double reefed top sail fore sail jib & spanker. scooped the oil off the Pals & cleaned them out. Copper employed in cooping the oil for stowing. Tues March 2nd

727th

This day commences the same finished cooping the oil (for the main sail) were ship at 1 1/2 o'clock. took out water. Mid part fresh breeze from the S.E. steering by the wind under double reefed top sail & courses. Latter part fresh breeze from the S.E. steering by the wind on the Port tack. hauled the main sail at 6 o'clock commenced stowing down oil in fifth hold
