Mon March 6th

This day commenced the same ship heading N.E. by N. at sundown double reefed the top sail & furled the main sail jib & spanker. Had luffed to the wind on the Starboard tack. Mid part the same. Latter part moderate breeze ship on different tacks. Cooper employed in Bicke. Steaming casks. Caught & salted a barrel of water of Albicore. Lat 17.44 Long 1.266

Tue March 7th/71

This day commenced with a fresh breeze ship heading E. on the Starboard tack. Broke out a task of coal (hooked out on head it) stowed the empty casks in the blubber room & washed the paint work inside of the ship. Mid part steering by the wind on the Starboard tack. Latter part fresh trades ship on different tacks. Lat 16.57 South Long 2.07 East
