

At Sea on Board Bk Globe

734th

Thursday March 9th

This day commenced with moderate breeze ship heading S.W. on the Port tack at sundown shortened sail as usual. Mid part the same over ship at 10 o'clock. Latter part fresh breeze so the crew a cork reef out & set main sail & flying jib (crusing).
Lat 17.34 Long 11.34 East

Friday March 10th

This day commenced with moderate breeze ship heading S.W. on the Port tack at sundown shortened sail & wore around. Mid part good weather. Latter part hazy steering W by N, set the reef out. Lat 17.34 Long 11.16 East

Sat March 11th

This day commenced the same. Mid part ship heading E by S by the wind on the Starboard tack. Latter part fine weather made all sail. broke out water. Lat 17.33 Long 10.46

Sun March 12th

This day commenced with a high breeze from the S.E. steering W by N. at sundown luffed to on the Port tack & shortened sail. Mid part the same. Latter part light breeze from the S.E. steering W under all sail. Lat 18.04 Long 10.08 West

738th

Mon March 13th

This day commenced with fine weather steering W. at sundown shortened sail and luffed to the wind on the Starboard tack. Mid part the same at 5¹/₂ o'clock wore ship steering W. set the reef out & opened the last cork of beer.
Lat 18.02 Long 00.56 West

739th

Tues March 14th

This day commenced with a steady breeze from the S.E. steering West under top sail & courses at sundown reefed the top sail (and luffed to the wind on the Starboard tack). Mid part steering N. Latter part steering W by N. set the reef out - watch employed in dailizing.
Lat 17.40 Long 2.16 West

740th

Wed March 15th

This day commenced with a fresh breeze steering W by N. at sundown double reefed and luffed to on the Port tack. Mid part the same. Latter part fresh breeze steering N.W. set the reef out of main top sail. watch employed in dailizing. saw a sail.

741th

Thurs March 16th

This day commenced the same at sundown shortened sail & luffed to on the Starboard tack. Mid part the same. Latter part fresh breeze steering N. under reefed top sail & courses. broke out water. saw a sail.

742th

Friday March 17th

This day commenced the same at sundown luffed to the wind on the Port tack & set the reef out of the main top sail. watch employed in dailizing. Mid part strong breeze. Latter part the same steering to the N.W. set the reef out of the main top sail.
Lat March 18th

743th

This day commenced with fresh breeze steering N. put the new net on the gun of the fore top sail yard. saw a Whaling ship. Bk heading to the N & E at sundown shortened sail & luffed to the wind on the S. tack.
