Maid part the same Latter fresh breeze made all sail steering by the wind on the Port took raised the Land at day-light about 40 miles distant spoke the Bk Leonides Capt. Shetler having taken 70 lbs sperm the last cruise on the same line saw several merchantmen

This day commenced with light breeze at sundown parted from the Lat Bark at sundown shortened sail Maid part steering by the wind on the Starboard tack Latter part made all sail (cruising) saw several merchantmen

745th

Mon March 20th

This day commenced with fine weather spoke & commenced the Bk Gazelle Capt. Gifford 5 months from home with 25 lbs sperm oil on board at sundown shortened sail Maid part the same at 10 1/2 o'clock parted from this Lat Bark Latter part fresh breeze for the reef out & set the course jibs & spanker Gazelle in sight watch employed in sailing

746th

Tues March 21st

This day commenced with a moderate breeze from the S.E. steering by the wind under top sail & course Maid part steering the same course ship at 12 o'clock Latter part the same set the reef out. saw a whaler broke out water & crew

747th

Wednesday March 22nd

This day commenced the same at 4 1/2 o'clock spoke the Brig Starlight Capt. Croas 2 months out with 1160 lbs sperm at sundown shortened sail to double reefed top sail & fore sail Maid part fresh breeze at 10 o'clock parted from the Lat Bark Latter part strong breeze set the reef out steering by the wind on the Starboard tack the Brig in sight

748th

Thursday March 23rd

This day commenced the same Starlight in sight Maid part steering by the wind under top sail course jibs & spanker on the Starboard tack Latter part the same made all sail Starlight in sight watch employed in sailing

749th

Friday March 24th

This day commenced the same saw a school of porpoise Maid part steering by the wind on the Starboard tack Latter part the same Starlight in sight burned one of the old stoves up and painted her under the ceiling Long 2.21

750th

Sat March 25th

This day commenced with light breeze steering by the wind heading E under all sail Starlight in sight Maid part the same Latter part strong breeze accompanied with rain & squalls broke out water Starlight in sight
