

Remarks on Board Bk Globe

803th

May Friday 19th

This day commences with strong trades ship heading E by S under all sail at 3 1/2 o'clock took in the main top gallant sail & Mizzen top mast-stay sail & a crew to main top gallant sail. Mid part strong trades ship heading E by S. Latter part the same ship heading East. set the main top gallant sail took it in again at 9 o'clock

806th

Sat May 20th / 71

This day commences with fresh trades stirring by the wind on the Starboard tack heading E by S. Mid part fresh breeze Latter part moderate breeze ship heading E by S under all sail on the Starboard tack. broke out water and wet the hold. Lat 11.07 & Long 3.37 East

807th

Sunday May 21st

This day commences with light trades ship heading East under all sail watch employed in fitting Boat gear. Mid part steady breeze ship under all sail heading E. S. E. Latter part fresh trades stirring by the wind on the Starboard tack under all sail. Lat 10.48 & Long 3.31

808th

Mon May 22nd / 71

This day commences with fresh trades stirring by the wind on the Starboard tack heading E by S under all sail. Mid part the same Latter part moderate breeze from the S. S. W stirring by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack

Long 7.04

809th

Thursday May 23rd / 71

This day commences with a moderate breeze from the S. S. W ship heading S E by the wind on the Starboard tack employed in making lance poles & repairing the draw gale Buckers. broke out Bif & a Cask of Bread Mid part the same Latter part light breeze from the S. S. W stirring by the wind on the Starboard tack under all sail

Lat 10.30
Long 8.70 East

Friday May 24th

This day commences with a moderate breeze from the S. S. W ship heading S. E under all sail. cut a jib for the Main Boat. set up the flying jib guys &c Mid part wind light from the S. S. W. Latter part the same employed in making fishing line Lat 10.30 Long 9.07

811th

Thursday May 25th

This day commences with light breeze from the S. S. W ship heading S. E under all sail set turned in the fore top gallant rigging & set it up. Cooper engaged in making fishing line reel Mid part moderate. Latter part the same broke out water and made sinker for fishing Lat 10.38 Long 9.39 East

812th

Friday May 26th

This day commences with a light breeze from the S. S. W stirring South under all sail repaired the main sail. Mid part light breeze Latter part the same rigged out the cutting stage nothing in sight
