834th June Sat 17th/71
This day commenced with a calm
3 Boats left the ship on a day's cruise
at 6.0 clock Boats returned to the
Broke ship have seen nothing today except
out water a fin (Back) Nauticus & Starlings
got underway and anchored near
by us boiled the whale turned up
13. bbl

835th June Sun 18th/71
This day commenced with a moderate
breeze 3 Boats left the ship on a day's
cruise chased 2 large Cow Whales
about 10 miles to the leeward of the
ship but did not succeed in striking
them. Saw the Nauticus Boats
chasing Whales but did not strike

836th June Mon 19th/71
This day commenced with a moderate
breeze at 6.0 clock lowered 3 Boats and
gave chase at 8.0 clock the Bow
Boat struck a 20 bbl Whale and turned
him up towed him along side the
ship got underway and cast the
Boats cut him in and started
for more whales at 11.2.0 clock
the Starboard Boat struck a 30 bbl
Whale turned him up and towed
him along side and cut him
in. Saw the Nauticus Boats towing
a whale to the ship at sundown
had the Whale in on deck (Pore
the Starboard Boat sail nearly
in to.) during the night watches
employed in cutting up blubber

On The Coast of Africa

837th June Tues 20th
This day commenced with a
light breeze all hands employed in
cutting up blubber and stowing it in
the trail hatch. After getting dinner
Main & Bow Boats left the ship in
pursuit of Whales. Saw one going
quick was unable to strike him at
sundown returned to the ship. Saw a
schooner bound down the coast.
(Started the work at 3.0 clock divided
the crew into 3 watches for the night
upward the Starboard Boat sail

838th June Wednes 21st
This day commenced with a moderate
breeze at 6.0 clock 3 Boats left the
ship on a day's cruise. Hands shared
employed in boiling. Saw a steamer
bound down the coast. At sundown
Boats returned to the ship. have seen
nothing this day. At sundown finished
Boiling turned up 45 bbl (Broke out water)

839th June Thurs 22nd
This day commenced with a light breeze
at 6.20 clock 4 Boats left the ship
in pursuit of Whales at sundown
returned to the ship. Saw 2 Whales
this day

840th June Friday 23rd/71
This day commenced with a calm
4 Boats left the ship in pursuit of
Whales Bow & Main Boats chased
2 Whales out sight of the ship. Saw 13k
Nauticus take a whale also saw the Starlings later

Broke out a
fin of Bow
