

Continued Remarks

841st

June Sat 24th/71

This day commences with a fresh breeze. All 4 Boats left the ship for a days cruise. At sundown Boats returned have seen no whales this day.

842nd

June Sun 25th

This day commences with a light sea breeze. All 4 Boats in pursuit of Whales. Saw the Leonidae take a whale. Saw the Brig F. H. Moore to the windward. Saw 3 Whales to day.

843rd

June Mon 26th

This day commences with a moderate Breeze. All 4 Boats cruising. At sundown Boats returned to the ship have seen no whales this day.

844th

June Tues 27th

This day commences with a moderate breeze from the S.W. all 4 Boats in pursuit of Whales. At sundown Boats returned to the ship have seen nothing this day.

845th

June Wednes 28th

This day commences with a fine breeze from the S.W. 3 Boats left the ship on a days cruise. At sundown Boats came aboard have seen 3 Whales this day. Brig F. H. Moore came down and anchored near by us.

846th

June Thurs 29th

This day commences with a calm at 7 o'clock lowered 3 Boats & chased Whales until 4 o'clock & returned to the ship with provisions anchored at sundown. Several Whales seen at night.

The Coast off Africa

847th

June Friday 30th

This day commences with a light breeze from the S.W. lowered 3 Boats and pulled to the windward. At 3 o'clock the Boat struck a small whale and the line became foul therefore cut from him. Saw the Brig Fava near by. Saw the Starlight chase a whale at 7 1/2 o'clock. Boat returned to the ship. Broke out a Bbl of Flour.

848th

July Sat 1st/70

This day commences with a light breeze (all 4 Boats cruising) at sundown Boats came aboard have seen 3 whales. Saw the Nautilus & Starlight take a whale each. (overhauled today).

849th

July lowered 3 Boats Sunday 2nd

This day commences with a calm lowered 4 Boats to cruise. At 4 o'clock the Bow Boat struck a 20 bbl whale and turned him up. The ship got underway working up the coast. anchored at 9 o'clock. At night at 6 o'clock commenced towing. At 3 o'clock got the whale along side.

850th

July Mon 3rd/71

This day commences the same as 6 o'clock called all hands and commenced cutting. At 8 o'clock had him in on deck. 3 Boats left the ship in pursuit of whales. At sundown Boats came aboard have seen nothing to day. cut up the flubber and put it in the flubber room.
