

Continued Remarks

851st

July 4th/71

This day commenced with a calm
lowered all 4 Boats. Shortly after raised
2 whale the Starboard & Waist Boats
gave chase but did not succeed in
striking. at 12 o'clock Bow Boat
raised 12 large Cow Whale and struck
one of them and turned him up
off shore about 6 mile distance. Then
Waist Boat shot a bomb lance into
the loose whale which crippled him
after the whale turned ^{up} when he
immediately sunk in 30 fathoms
of water. The Boat layed by the whale
and I went aboard the ship after
getting supper I started for the whale
off shore to relieve the Mate. but
he did not want to come aboard
as he was ~~afraid~~ ^{afraid} of him
Self. of something of the kind
therefore I came aboard again. got
aboard at 8 o'clock. wishing Boat
Coggshall a happy night's repose
will now retire

852nd

July 5th/71

This day commenced the same started
the work boating on the small whale
sent the Bow Boat off shore to the
sunk whale to relieve the Starboard
Boat crew

853rd

July 6th/71

This day commenced the same. during
the night I was off shore by the dead
whale. at 8 1/2 o'clock hauled the whale
up and commenced towing for the ship
at 3 1/2 o'clock got him along side at 8 1/2 o'clock
^{had him up on}

854th

July 7th/71

This day commenced with a light sea
breeze started the work. saw the ~~St. H. Moore~~
Boats towing a whale broke out tracks from
the fore hold. at 6 40 o'clock for the
waist Starboard Waist first watch
in. (during the night sailing)
finished Boating at 2 o'clock. Towed up 73th

855th

July 8th/71

This day commenced with a calm
all hands employed in stowing down in
the fore hold. saw the ~~St. H. Moore~~ Boats
in pursuit of whale at 7 1/2 o'clock
finished stowing for the day. leaving the
last whale on deck. had stowed down 75
bls. to day

856th

July 9th/71

This day commenced with a light
breeze lowered 3 Boats for cruising at
1 1/2 o'clock the Starboard Boat struck
a 15 bl Whale there was another one with-
time I struck the waist whale. and I
took the Waist Boats iron into my
Boat and struck the other one (which
was about 35 bl Whale. after the small
one turned up I started for the Waist
Boats Whale & struck him at 4 o'clock
the whale turned up and sunk
in about 15 fathoms of water. left the
Waist Boats crew by the whale
for the night. the ship got underway
and took the small whale
along side and anchored in
12 fathoms of water. (Capt. Bassett
came aboard) (Broke out a Bl of
Beef) saw the Varditus cutting a whale
