869<sup>th</sup>

Sunday Jan 22<sup>nd</sup> /71

This day commences with a fresh breeze got underway and worked the ship to the whale took the whale along side at 9 o'clock. Looked on & cut him in after cutting the whale back forward on the Starboard. Tack heading on shore saw the Bks Briton & Draco to the leeward. 2<sup>nd</sup> Onals (Mer Reed) came aboard started the work at 12 o'clock during the night employed in boiling Starboard water having the 1<sup>st</sup> watch on deck

870<sup>th</sup>

Sunday Jan 23<sup>rd</sup> /71

This day commences with a calm finished boiling last night at 3 o'clock. Turned up 24 bbls at 7 o'clock. Began a commenced stowing down in the fore hold at 4 1/2 o'clock knocked off of the work. Have stowed down 86 bbls this day since being here on the coast we have stowed down 209 bbls

871<sup>st</sup>

Sunday Jan 24<sup>th</sup> /71

This day commences with a light breeze from the S & W all hands employed in stowing down oil in the fore hold. Began a stowed down 43 bbls. This makes us 233 bbls of oil we have stowed down since we arrived on the coast. At 3 o'clock finished stowing and started up decks stowed 4 casks of Flour in the after hold

## On The Coast of Africa

872<sup>nd</sup>

Sunday Jan 25<sup>th</sup> /71

This day commences with a calm lowered 4 Boats on a cruise. Saw 2 whales during the day. Saw the Narwhals & Starlights to the leeward. At sundown Boats came aboard. Saw a steamer at anchorage off Amberges.

873<sup>rd</sup>

Sunday Jan 26<sup>th</sup> /71

This day commences with a light breeze at 7 o'clock got underway made all sail standing down the coast. At 10 o'clock raised a whale lowered 3 Boats and chased him down the coast about 5 miles and gave it up as a bad job & returned to the ship. Saw the Bks Briton & Draco to the leeward. Saw the Boats towing a whale at sundown anchored in 12 fathoms of water near the Briton & Draco

874<sup>th</sup>

Sunday Jan 27<sup>th</sup> /71

This day commences with a light breeze from the Eastward at 7 o'clock got underway made all sail heading down the coast. Shortly after lowered 3 Boats to cruise along with the ship. At sundown Boats returned to the ship having seen 1 whale spoke the Pilot boat with 130 bbls.

875<sup>th</sup>

Sunday Jan 28<sup>th</sup> /71

This day begins with moderate weather lowered 3 Boats on a day's cruise got underway made all sail standing down the coast. At sundown Boats came aboard have seen 1 whale this day <sup>during the evening</sup> <sup>gambling with the</sup> <sup>H. Moore</sup>
