

Remarks on Board Bk Globe

876th

Saturday Jan 29th/71

This day commences with a fresh breeze from the Southward at 6 o'clock got underway standing down the coast under all sail lowered 3 Boats to cruise saw the St. H. Moore chasing whales at Sundown Boat came aboard have seen 2 whales this day at Sundown came to anchor off Congo River on the Southside. Broke out a cask of Bread.

877th

Sunday Jan 30th/71

This day commences with a light breeze from the Southward at 3 o'clock called all hands got underway standing across Congo River under all sail last evening the Brig anchored near by. The Capt. came aboard at 1 o'clock the wind died away and finding that the ship was drifting off shore anchored in 23 fathoms of water. (Saw the Brig anchor)

Sunday Jan 31st/71

This day commences with light weather last night at 8 o'clock called all hands and got the ship underway trying to work in shore but as the wind died away anchored again in 25 fathoms of water. This morning at 7 o'clock got underway standing S.W. at 4 o'clock wind died away and finding that the ship was making more leeway than headway anchored in 33 fathoms of water land not visible

On the Coast of Africa

879th

Sunday August 1st/71

This day commences with a moderate breeze from the Southward at 7 o'clock got underway leaving in shore with a light breeze saw several hump-backs at 5 1/2 o'clock wind died away therefore anchored in 34 fathoms of water. Hauled up 45 fathoms of the Starboard cable and bent the chain to the Starboard anchor in case of emergency

880th

Monday Aug 2nd/71

This day commences with a light breeze at 4 1/2 o'clock called all hands and got underway trying to work in shore at 2 o'clock raised the land about 8 miles distant. Saw the Starlight chasing whales. Broke out a Bbl of Port. and a Bbl of Flour. at Sundown anchored in 15 fathoms of water repaired the draw water bucket.

881st

Tuesday Aug 3rd

This day commences with a calm got the ship underway standing down the coast. lowered 3 Boats for a days cruise saw 2 leisters standing up the Coast at Sundown Boat came aboard have seen a whale to day and chased him so that he gave up. So ends the day of hump-backing at Sundown anchored in 25 fathoms of water

882nd

Wednesday Aug 4th/71

This day commenced with a calm accompanied with a fog. got the Loango ship underway at 6 o'clock standing in shore saw the Starlight chasing whales here at anchor. H. Moore has taken 45 hump-backs to day
