On Board Bk Globe of New Bedford

at 9 o'clock raised a whale about
a mile from the ship. Covered 2 Boats
and gave chase at 10 o'clock the
Bow Boat struck a 30 bl whale and
turned him up off shore and commenced
rowing to the larward. at 1 o'clock the
ship anchored as there was but wind sufficient
to stem the current. Rowed until 9 o'clock
in the evening and then anchored the
whale and the Starboard & Larboard Boats
went aboard leaving the Bow Boat to
lay by the whale during the night.
Drew the Clinton & Draco Gase by hauled
to the larward also Mr. G. H. Moore

Aug Sun 27th / 71

This day commenced with a
calm at 5 1/2 o'clock got the ship underway
working towards the whale. hooked 2 Boats
on the bow the ship. at 8 o'clock arrived
to the whale and anchored in 2 fathoms
of water. Found that the confounded
sharks had eaten about 1/3 of the
whale at 9 o'clock hooked on to
the whale and at 11 1/2 o'clock had
him cut in cleared up deck and
commenced cutting up the blubber
and mincing. Saw the Starlight and
G. H. Moore to the windward. at
1 o'clock set in thick and rainy
have seen nothing this day
