

Continued Remarks Humpbacking

906th day Moon Aug 28th/71

This day commenced with a calm at 5 1/2 o'clock started the smoke boiling on the last whale. broke out on the after noon) the after hold for low line cage to fill with oil. also broke out a keg of Butter and emptied the Rice Cask for oil. saw the Starlight heading down the coast during the night fire and this saw a whale face by near the ship at 10 1/2 o'clock finished boiling. turned up 30 bbls. (Her Pile up about the same)

907th day Star Aug 29th/71

This day commenced with a calm lowered the Larboard and Bow Boats for a whale near the ship but returned without him (saw the Starlight to the windward) at 12 1/2 o'clock commenced stowing down oil in the fore hold. at 6 o'clock finished stowing off the fore hold. stowed down 33 bbls

908th day Wednesday Aug 30th

This day commenced with a light breeze at 6 o'clock commenced stowing down oil in the After Hold. at 12 o'clock finished stowing oil. stowed down 22 bbls. broke out a cask of Beer from the fore hold. at 1 1/2 o'clock got underway and made all sail standing up the coast saw 2 whales bound to the southward. cleared off the cuts and put them below. at sunset anchored in 19 fathoms water

Off Mumba Bay 1871

909th day Thurs Aug 31st/71

This day commenced with a calm at 9 o'clock Boats left the ship for crumming. at 6 o'clock Boats came aboard. Have seen several whales this day but was unable to strike any of them. saw the Nauticus & H. Moore to the windward at 6 1/2 o'clock sent down & stowed the cutting tackle away and got the ship underway standing off shore under all sail on the Bow took with a fresh breeze from the S & W (Farewell to this confounded Coast I never desire to see it more). Stowed the anchor on the Bow.

during our last season here on the Coast I have been keeping shore time. but as we are leaving the Coast for Annabona Islands I shall proceed on with sea time.

910th day Friday Sept 1st/71

This day commenced with a light breeze. got underway standing off shore ship heading West under all sail. got underway at 6 1/2 o'clock. Aided part wind died away to a calm. Letter part the same. saw the Land. watch employed in cleaning the off the ship. Prepared the fore top gallant sail
