

On Board Bk Globe From the Coast
To Annabona

911th day Sept Sat. 2nd 1871
This day commence with a light breeze from the S.W. steering N.W. & under all sail saw 2 Hump Backe near the ship. Mead part took a light breeze from the N.E. steering N.W. under all sail. at 11.0 - clock sounded but found no bottom. Latter part light breeze from the E. steering N.W. watch employed in washing the inside of the ship saw Hump Backe & porpoise
Leat 3.24. South Long 9.19 East

912th Sept Sun. 3rd /71
This day commence the same steam the same. saw porpoise. watch employed in various jobs about the ship. caught a porpoise. Mead part light breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind under all sail on the Port tack. Latter part fine breeze from the S.E. steering West under all sail on the Port tack saw several Hump Backe & Fin Backe also saw porpoise.
Leat 3.10 Long 8.76

913th Sept Mon 4th /71
This day commence with a light breeze from the S.W. ship heading W. under all sail saw porpoise. spliced a shot of new line on the Bow & Starboard Bows. Mead part steady breeze from the E. steering N.W. & N. Latter part moderate breeze from the Eastward steering N.W. & N. under all sail. saw a porpoise & Fin Backe
Leat 3.38 Long 6.53

To Annabona & Sept Tues 5th /71
914th This day commence with a light breeze from the S.E. steering to the N.W. under all sail. saw porpoise & Fin Backe. broke out water. scraped down the masts. watch employed in salting. Mead part moderate breeze from the S.E. steering N.W. under all sail. Latter part the same. flushed down & scraped the mizzen top - mast, Leat 2.00 Long 5.56
915th day Sept Wednes 6th /71

This day commence with a light breeze from the S.E. steering N.W. under all sail. caught a large Albicore. the Land is about 30 miles distant. it being thick & hazy are not able to see the Land nor our fore-top gallant shrouts. Mer Riley is rather more on the gain. Mead part light breeze from the S.W. at 8.0 - clock luffed to on the Starboard tack steering the light ship on different tack. Latter part light breeze from the S.W. steering to the N.W. under all sail. at 8.0 - clock saw the Land bearing N.W. caught several Albicore and other fish
Leat 3.12 Long 8.12

916th Sept Thurs 7th /71
This day commence with a moderate breeze from the S.W. steering in for the Land under all sail. at 8.0 - clock came to anchor. after towing the ship in shore some rigging. saw at anchor Bk Briton & Deaco. have taken a Whale since they have been here. the Natives came aboard half crazy or apparently so.
