933th

Sept. Tues 26th/71

This day commence with a light breeze from the S & W ship heading S. S. E. under all sail watch engaged in caulking Cooper employed in making fresh Water Buckets. Mid part light breeze from the S & W ship on the Starboard tack under all sail. Latter part the same watch employed in scraping & painting the chain plate. Also painting the other iron work on the side of the ship. Cooper engaged in making Buckets. Lat 6. 50. Long 9. 19 East

936th

Sept. Wednesday 27th/71

This day commence the same watch employed in cleaning & painting iron work. Tacked ship at 12:30 - clock. Mid part light breeze from the S & W steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack. Latter part the same saw fin Back. Broke out meat. (Bef) Cooper employed in making a new Grind Stone tub. Lat 7. 18 Long 10. 3

937th

Thurs Sept 28th/71

This day commence with a light breeze from the S. W. steering by the wind under all sail heading S. E. watch employed in making roving & Dennis. Mid part light breeze ship heading S. E. by S under all sail. Latter part light breeze steering by the wind on the Port tack finished the Grind Stone tub and hung the stone. Watch employed in making Dennis. Lat 7. 30 Long 10. 11

From Annabona up the Coast

938th

Friday Sept 29th/71

This day commence with a moderate breeze from the W. S. W. steering by the wind under all sail on the Port tack. at 5:00 - clock tacked ship heading S by E. saw porpoise. Mid part moderate weather. Latter part fresh breeze from the S & W steering by the wind under all sail on the Port tack saw porpoise. Lat 7. 50 Long 10. 13 East

939th

Sat Sept 30th

This day commence with a moderate breeze from the S & W steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack saw porpoise. cleared the Caboose cover out and put it on. Mid part light breeze from the S & W. Latter part steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack. Watch employed in painting the chain plate. Lat 8. 30 Long 10. 41 East

940th

Sun October 1st/71

This day commence with a light breeze from the S. W. ship heading S. S. E. under all sail saw porpoise & porpoise. Mid part light breeze from the S. S. W steering by the wind on the Port tack under all sail. Latter part nearly calm saw porpoise. To day being Sunday I would like to spend the day at home but instead I am here on board Bk Globe in the Latitude of 8. 38. Long 10. 11
