949th

Oct. Tues 10th

This day commences with a moderate breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack. Saw five Black watch employed in darning. As sundown did away to a calm. Meid part calm. Latter part light breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind under all sail on the Port tack (saw five Black)

950th

October Wednes 11th/11

This day commences with a light breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind under all sail on the Port tack. Saw five Black watch employed in putting buckets to the Buckets. Meid part moderate breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack. Latter part fresh breeze from the Southward steering by the wind under all sail on the Port tack. Saw several Fin Backs

951th

October Thurs 12th

This day commences with a fresh breeze ship heading N.W. by the wind under all sail. Saw several Fin Backs. Meid part fresh breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind under all sail on the Port tack. Latter part strong breeze from the S.W. steering by the wind under all sail. Saw a school of Blackfish employed in rearing new gunning gillie &c. At 12 o'clock latched ship heading E.S.E. by the wind

952nd

October Friday 13th

This day commences with a strong breeze from the S. steering by the wind took in the fore top gallant sail & part top sail. Saw five Black Meid part strong breeze from the Southward. Steering by the wind under all sail except fore top g. sail & part top sail. Latter part the same latched ship at 8 o'clock broke out water and the slop cask (saw Blackfish)

953rd

October Sat. 14th/11

This day commences with a fresh breeze from the Southward. Saw porpoise watch employed in putting buckets to the Buckets. Meid part steering by the wind under the same sail on the Port tack caught 2 porpoise. Latter part fresh breeze from the S. steering by the wind found the flying jib guy to be stranded sent it in. Made a new one & sent it out & set it up. Broke out Flour. Fish Mollase & a Bbl of Pork. (no observation)

954th day

October Sun 15th/11

This day commences with a fresh breeze from the S. steering by the wind on the Starboard tack. Black watch employed in washing deck. Meid part westerly breeze from the S. steering by the wind under all sail on different tack. Latter part wind light & backing ship on the Starboard tack under all sail. Look 7.15. Lat 41.2.
