

Continued Remarks on Board Bk Globe

935th

October Mon 16th/71

This day commence with a light breeze from the Southward Ship on the Starboard tack under all sail. Nothing in sight. Me id part fresh breeze from the S. Steering by the wind under all sail on the Port tack. Latter part wind light & baffling Ship on the Port tack under all sail. Saw Fin Backs & porpoises.

936th

Oct. Tues 17th/71

This day begins the same. nothing in sight. Ship on the same tack Me id part Ship on the Port tack. Latter part moderate breeze from the S & W Ship on different tack working Southwly under all sail. nothing in sight. Took in the cutting stage and unrigged at & painted the stanchions.

937th

October Wednes 18th/71

This day commence with a steady breeze from the S & W. Steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack. Me id part fresh breeze from the S. Steering by the wind under all sail on the Port tack. Latter part light breeze Ship on the same tack. at 11 o'clock raised a school of Sperm Whales.

Repaired the fore top gallant sail and bent it.

Oct 19. 14

October Thursday 19th/71

This day commence with a moderate breeze from the S. bent the fore top gallant sail. at 1.12. o'clock lowered the Mast. Leeward. & Bow Boats and gave chase to the whale. at 4. o'clock the Mast Boat struck a 30 blt Whale and the Bow Boat struck second Boat there was another Whale which run with the first one and the Leeward Boat struck him. The lines became foul which caused the Mast Boat to cut line as this whale was spouting blood. the Mast Boat chased the wounded whale some time but was unable to strike him. The Bow Boat cut from the whale as soon as the whale spouted blood in order to strike a loose one if possible. the Starboard Boat lowered from the ship to assist the Leeward Boat. after pulling up with the Leeward Boats to whale the Bow Boat struck the whale 2nd Boat it was then about dark and the whale was spouting blood. Me id part strong breeze from the Southward at 7.12. 9 o'clock took whale along side and fluked him. doubled reefed the main top sail and took in the fore top sail laying aback then was laying to with whale along side. Latter part strong breeze from the S. at 6. 9 o'clock commenced cutting & at 10. o'clock had him in on deck. Sent down the tackle & stowed them away. Lat 12. 07. Long 5. 50
