

Continued Remarks Sperm Whaling

Meid part light breeze wore ship at 8.0 clock heading W by S under the same sail cleared away the jaw and started the work boiling on the head. Latter part fresh breeze all hands employed in boiling & cutting up joints.

969th Long 3.00 Lat 13. 60

October Mon 30th

The day commenced the same employed in boiling wore ship at 4.0 clock at 5 1/2. 0-clock raised a school of Sperm Whales going to the windward immediately towards the vessel & Bow Boat and chased them a about an hour but was unable to get on to them returned to the ship at 7 1/2. 0-clock Meid part squally with rain showers employed in boiling finished boiling on the head at 7. 6-clock and commenced on the Body wore ship at 2.0 clock heading W by S. under all sail except top of sail. Latter part fresh breeze from the S. S. W wore ship at 7 1/2. 0-clock watch employed in boiling. (Leardboard watch below) Started the tub out of the cask for oil also emptied a Bread cask. (Mer Coggshall no better) Put the again up gallantail.

970th Thursday October 31st/71

The day commenced with a fresh breeze from the S. W. wore ship at 3. 0-clock. Leardboard watch employed in boiling. Nothing in sight. Meid part fresh breeze from the S. S. W finished boiling at 9. 0-clock and put on the steam. (Turned up 11 bell) Latter part moderate breeze ship on the Port tack heading S. W watch employed in cleaning the whole jaw and scooping off the oil from the flat lean. wore ship at 13. 24 Lat 13. 24

Long 4. 58 East

971th Wednesday Nov 1st/71

The day commenced the same emptied the brace apple cask and the iron hoop cask for to stem for oil at 3. 0-clock took off the steam and cleaned out the pots. Saw porpoise at 3 1/2. 0-clock tacked ship heading S. E. on the Starboard tack Meid part steady breeze from the S. S. W steering by the wind on different tacks Latter part fresh breeze from the S. steering by the wind on the Port tack under full sail cooper employed in cooping the oil for showing down tomorrow. saw a school of Killers. Mer Coggshall rather better.
