972nd

Nov. Thursday 2nd

This day commenced with a fresh breeze from the S. Ship on the Starboard tack heading ESE under all sail. Cooper employed in coopersing the oil. Meid part fresh breeze from the Southward Ship on the Port tack took in the fore top gallant sail & gaff top sail. Wore ship at 4¹/₂ o'clock. Leathur part strong breeze from the S. Ship on the same tack took in the main top gallant sail. at 5¹/₂ o'clock commenced heaving out the after hold in order to stow oil.

973rd

November Friday 3rd

This day commenced the same all hands engaged in stowing down oil. Stowed down 40 bbls. at 3¹/₂ o'clock finished stowing off the after hold have stowed down the day about 40 bbls more or less. took in Gaffen top mast stay sail and flying jib. Wind increasing. I will here remark one thing in regard to stowing down oil. I have worked harder in stowing what little we have than I ever did in stowing from 100 to 150 bbls in ships that I have previously sailed in. But never mind this tantalizing work cannot last much longer before I hope to be a free drakey once more. Meid part strong breeze. Leathur part fresh breeze accompanied with rain squalls. Cooper employed in coopersing the oil to stow between decks. Lat 13.35 Long 5.35

Nov. Saturday 4th/71

This day commenced with a fresh breeze from the Southward Ship on the Starboard tack heading ESE under whole top-sails course jib & spanker. at 12 o'clock called the watch and stowed the remainder of the oil between decks in the main hold. Stowed down 31 bbls what we stowed yesterday and today is 71 bbls (not the oil in the lower holds). Meid part steering by the wind under the same sail. Leathur part strong breeze from the S.E. steering West double reefed the top-sails. Broke out water but the main

975th

Nov. Sun 5th/71

This day commenced the same steering West under reefed top sails & course at 5¹/₂ o'clock wore ship heading E. on the Starboard tack. Meid part strong breeze from the S.E. Ship on the Starboard tack. took in the main sail. Leathur part strong breeze steering West ~~set~~ the main sail. Lat 14.08. Long 5.10

976th

Nov. Monday 6th/71

This day commenced with a moderate breeze from the S.E. steering S.W by W under whole top sail and course. Nothing in sight. at sundown double reefed the top sails and luffed to the wind on the Port tack. Leathur part strong breeze from the Southward steering by the wind ~~set~~ the reef out. Water into the hull. Lat 14.35 Long 3.59
