 Meid part fresh Trade Leather part the
 same Starboard watch on Liberty the
 Water Boat came along side and pumped
 aboard 90 bbl of water. Her Montardian
 from the Tomb came aboard to get some
 done flowers for the Capt. to take home
 (the Cooper is still ashore)

998th Tues Nov 28th/71

This day commence with a moderate
 breeze from the S.E. Starboard watch on
 Liberty. Stowed the water below and
 washed off the deck took aboard 8 bags
 of Potatoes several ships have touched here
 to day. Meid part the same Leather part
 fine weather Starboard watch on Liberty
 (lost the oil in the lower holds)

999th

Wednes Nov 29th

This day commence with fine
 weather Meid part the same Leather part
 fresh here accompanied with rain squalls
 Starboard watch on Liberty. I went out in
 the Country to a grand picnic had a fine
 time. (Cooper came aboard)

1000th

Thurs Nov 30th/71

This day commence with a fresh
 breeze from the S.E. Meid part very pleasant
 weather Leather part fresh Trade Starboard
 watch on Liberty

1001st

Friday Dec 1st/71

This day commenced the same Meid
 part good weather Leather part the same this morning the
 Boat went in after the Liberty men all came off except
 the Cooper and the Cook

On Board Bk Globe of New Bedford
 1002nd day. Sat Dec 2nd/71

This day commence with moderate
 weather. Have seen several ships pass today
 Meid part fine weather Leather part fresh
 Trade. Water Boat came along side and
 pumped aboard 40 bbl of water

1003rd

Sun Dec 3rd/71

This day commence with a fresh
 breeze from the S.E. Stowed the water below
 and washed off the ship. Capt. sent off 27
 lbs of Mutton. Meid part fine weather
 all of the corn that went out of St Helena
 with us last April. have left the ship since
 we have been here. Leather part equally
 with rain

1004th

Mon Dec 4th/71

This day commence with fine
 weather Meid part the same. Leather
 part fresh Trade this morning at 5.0 o'clock
 the Mail Steamer arrived I received a
 letter by the said Mail

1005th

Tues Dec 5th/71

This day commence the same
 (lost hold) Meid part fine weather
 Leather part light Trade put the Port
 anchor on the Bow

1006th

Wednesday Dec 6th

This day commence with a light
 breeze from the S.E. Meid part good
 weather I was ashore during the night
 for the last time. had a pleasant time
 Leather part the same at 10.0 o'clock all hands
 on board took our anchor and put down to St Helena
 stowed the anchor and chain
