Dec Wednes 20th/71

This day commence with fresh trade accompanied with rain squalls steering the same under the same sail At sundown luffed to the wind and took in the light sail & double reefed Meid part fresh trades ship on the Starboard tack Latter part steering North under all sail

Dec Thurs 21st/71

This day commence the same saw albacore at sundown shortened sail as usual and luffed to the wind on the Starboard tack Meid part light weather Latter part the same made all sail steering N. Lat 13.15 Long 9.25

7022nd

Dec Friday 22nd/71

This day commence with light trades steering N. under all sail saw 2 merchantmen at sundown shortened sail as usual and luffed to the wind on the Starboard tack Meid part light breeze Latter part the same steering to the N.W. under all sail saw a school of Black fish going quick to the windward

7023rd

December Sat 23rd/71

This day commence the same steering N.W. under the same sail nothing in sight at sundown luffed to the wind on the Starboard tack and took in the light sail Meid part moderate weather Latter part the same made all sail steering N. Lat 11.55 Long 10.00

This day commence with a light breeze steering North under all sail a sail in sight at sundown took in the light sail and luffed to the wind on the Starboard tack Meid part steering by the wind Latter part fresh breeze steering West under top sails & fore-sail a sail in sight

Dec Mon 25th/71

This day commence with fresh trades steering W.N.W. a sail in sight at sundown luffed to the wind on the Port tack & double reefed Meid part the same Latter part strong trades steering West at the job How fare you Christmas

Dec Tues 26th/71

This day commence with strong trades steering W.N.W. at sundown luffed to the wind on the Port tack and took in the gib Meid part the same Latter part strong trade accompanied with rain squalls made new pendants to the job. Ship on the Starboard tack

Dec Wednes 27th/71

This day commence with fresh trade set the main sail steering by the wind on the Starboard tack Meid part the same Latter part fresh trades steering by the wind under whole top sails gib courses & shanks made new pendants to the fore & main stay sail
