7029th

Dec Friday 29th/71

This day commence with fresh trades stirring by the wind under all sail on the Port tack saw gunpowder at sundown shortline sail Me id part stirring by the wind all sail out except top & strike Leath part the same ship on the Port tack. Watch employed in making Spinn-yarn

Lat 13. 30

Long 11. 36

7030th

Dec Sat 30th/71

This day commence the same nothing in sight. Me id part moderate trades stirring by the wind under all sail on the Port tack Leath part the same repaired the cutting block strap. Saw a shark

Long 11. 39

Lat 14. 36

7031st

Dec Sun 31st/71

This day commence with fresh trades stirring by the wind under all sail Me id part light trades ship on different tack Leath part unsteady trades stirring by the wind under all sail. discovered the jib guy was parted rigged a tackle on to it for a preventer

7032nd

Jan Mon 1st/72

This day commence with light trades stirring by the wind under all sail on different tacks Me id part light trades stirring by the wind on the Port tack under all sail Leath part the same broke out water (not hold) found 4 hoops to be busted off the oil in the main hold took the wind out of the main hold & stowed it in the fore peak. Jan Tues 2nd/72

This day commence the same Cooper employed in putting new hoops on the Cask which have broke. Me id part light trades ship on the Port tack under all sail Leath part the same. nothing in sight Lat 17. 47. Long 11. 53

This day begins the same. nothing in sight Me id part light trades ship on the Port tack Leath part the same

7035th

Jan Thursday 4th/72

This day commence with a light breeze ship heading W.S.W on the Port tack Me id part light trades looked ship at 1 o'clock Leath part light trades looked ship at 7 1/2 o'clock

7036th

Jan Friday 5th/72

This day commence the same Me id part calm Leath part light breeze from the N.E. Stowing S.E. under all sail. nothing in sight caught a large fish
