

Remarks on Board the Globe of New Bedford - Alexander Gripper Master

1037th day Jan Sat-6th/72
This day commence with a light breeze from the N.E. steering S.E. under all sail on the Port tack Meid part calm Leatter part light breeze ship on different tack broke out water
Leat 20.00 Long 10.40

1038th day Jan Sun 7th/72
This day commence with light trades ship on the Port tack heading S.E. under all sail Meid part light baffling breeze ship on different tack Leatter part moderate breeze from the S. steering by the wind on different tack under all sail

1039th day Jan Mon 8th/72
This day commence the same steering by the wind under all sail. Nothing in light. Meid part light breeze ship on different tack Leatter part ship on the Starboard tack heading N.E. under all sail saw a Bill Fish. Leat 19.33 Long 10.11

1040th day Jan Tues 9th/72
This day commence with moderate trades steering the same Meid part light variable breeze ship on different tack Leatter part equally ship on different tack. Broke out Beef & Beans Leat 19.00 Long 10.04

1041th day Jan Wed 10th/72 Long 9.34
This day commence with moderate trades ship on the Starboard tack Meid part light breeze ship on different tack Leatter part equally steering by the wind on the Starboard tack under all sail. Broke out Beef & Beans also a new fire gun. - Broke

1042th day Jan Thursday 11th/72
This day commence with a fresh breeze from the E.S.E. steering by the wind on the Starboard tack under all sail Meid part fresh breeze steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack heading E.N.E. Leatter part strong trades heading N.E. by E under all sail parted fore brace & main top-gallant shunt (lost hold & broke out Beef & Pork Leat 17.05 Long 9.03 West

1043th day Jan Friday 12th/72
This day commence with fresh trades steering the same watch employed in sailoring & repaired the Rose. Meid part strong trades ship heading E.N.E. under all sail. Leatter part strong trades steering by the wind on the Starboard tack took in the top-gallant & part top sail. broke out water. Leat 16.05 Long 8.10

1044th day Jan Sat-13th/72
This day commence the same broke out a bag of Flour. (Caught a mouse & gave him to the dog) Meid part fresh trades. set the light sail. took in the gaff top sail & fore top of sail on a squall. Leatter part fresh trades ship on the Starboard tack sent down main top-gallant sail for repair saw a school of porpoise also saw 2 sails heading to the N.W. Leat 15.12 Jan Sun 14th Long 7.05

1045th day Jan Mon 15th/72
This day commence the same but main top of sail & set the light sail saw 2 sails (killed the pig) Meid part steering by the wind under all sail. Leatter part the same. ship heading
