

Continued Remarks On Board Bk Globe

1055th

Jan Wednes 24th/72

This day commences with strong trade steering West. At the light sails Mr Coggeshall was taken sick last Sunday and has not yet recovered. The Capt. has a numbness in his right arm was taken last night. At 6¹/₂ o'clock raised a white water to the windward luffed to the wind on the Starboard tack but did not see anything of it afterwards. At sundown took in the light sails and double reefed steering by the wind on the Port tack. Latter part strong trade set the reef out & set the light sails steering W by S. took out water

1056th

Jan Thursday 25th/72

This day commences the same at sundown took in the light sails and luffed to the wind on the Starboard tack. Mid part moderate trade accompanied with rain squalls. Latter part fresh breeze steering WSW under all sail rose our top-sail brace

1057th

Jan Friday 26th/72

This day commences with moderate trade steering W by S. at 3 o'clock raised the Land bearing West. At sundown took in the light sails & double reefed and luffed to the wind on the Port tack. (Mr Coggeshall no better) Mid part fine weather wore ship at 2 o'clock. Latter part fresh trade with rain squalls at 5¹/₂ o'clock kept off for the Land to Land the Mate. made all sail

Off St. Helena & In St. Helena

Jan Sat 27th/72

1058th

This day commences with moderate trade at 12 o'clock hauled slack off James town lowered the Starboard Bear. At 1 o'clock the Capt. & Mate ashore at 5 o'clock the Boat came aboard leaving the Mate & Capt. ashore for the night after coming aboard hauled up 50 fathoms of chain to the Starboard anchor and got the anchor off the Bow. Shall go in to anchor in the morning to get a raft of water at 6 o'clock Mr Smyth came aboard after his son Meid part working up off Barnes point. Saw the Bk Clergy Pop to the Luward. Latter part moderate trade made all daily feeding in shore at 6 o'clock sent the Starboard Boat in to Rupert Valley after the Capt. at 8 o'clock anchored off Rupert Valley. The water Boat came along side and pumped aboard 42 bbl of water sold 3 cabs of Groceries

1059th

Jan Sun 28th/72

This day commences the same at sundown closed up the sails & furlled the course. Merid part rainy. Latter part moderate breeze accompanied with rain squalls. I have been ashore to day and am about tired off St. Helena for this time. I wish that the Capt. would come aboard and take the ship to sea

1060th

Jan Mon 29th/72

This day commences with fine weather. Mid part moderate breeze. Latter part the same took aboard some cabbage &c sold 2 Bbl of Beef shipped a Man which left the Bk. Negro
