1061st

Jan Tue 30th/72

This day commence with moderate trade. The Mail Steamer arrived today also Bk Oray Capt. Howland 33 months out with 700 lbs. Meid part gaming with the O. Capt. crew. Latter part fine weather.

1062nd

Jan Wedne 31st/72

This day commence with a light breeze at 4 o'clock got underway and stood out to sea. After securing the anchor sent the Starboard Boat in. After the Capt. at sundown returned to the ship with all hands aboard squared away for Ascension in company with Oray Capt. Meid part steering N.N.W. under all sail. A boy made his appearance which stowed himself away at St Helena. Latter part moderate breeze steering N.N.W. under all sail Bk Oray. Craft in sight cut hold and repaired the lower deck beam hatches.

1063rd

Feb Thursday 1st/72

This day commence with moderate trade steering N.N.W. under all sail Bk Oray. Capt. in sight Meid part steering N.N.W. under all sail with light trade. Latter part the same. rose our fore hatches & chulins and rose our Bow Boat falls also rose our falls to the Starboard Boat rose our top sail halliards. Saw a school of whales. Bk Oray Capt. in sight.

From St Helena Toward Ascension

Feb Friday 2nd/72

This day commence with moderate trade steering N.W. by N under all sail at 4 1/2 o'clock spoke the Oray Capt. and the Capt. came aboard. Squared away again steering the same in company with the said ship. Meid part moderate breeze steering N.N.W. Latter part the same 4 falls in sight including the O. Capt. made a new Bow Spout Shroud and set it up. Lat 13 42 Long 8 38

1065th

Feb Sat 3rd/72

This day commence the same Meid part steering N.N.W. under all sail with a moderate breeze. Latter part the same 4 falls in sight including the Oray Capt. made a new Bow Spout Shroud and set it up. Lat 12 50 Long 9 38 W

1066th

Feb Sun 4th/72

This day commence with moderate trade steering N.N.W. under all sail repaired the top top sails and rose our shut. Meid part steering the same. Latter part fine weather steering N.N.W. under all sail.

1067th

Feb Mon 5th/72

This day commence with moderate trade steering N.N.W. gaming with the Oray Capt. Meid part fine weather spoke the gam at 10 30 o'clock. Latter part steering N.N.W. under all sail. Mr Coggeshall rather unwell. Lat 10 57 Long 11 48
