1086th day Feb Sat 24th /72

This day commence with moderate breeze from the N.E. steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack. Saw Black-fish & porpoise. Cray Fish & a Merchantman in sight. at sundown gained the Cray Fish. Mid part fine weather. Latter part light breeze from the N.E. steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack. Saw a Merchantman bound to the S.E.

Lat 4. 14 Long 24. 26
1087th Feb Sun 25th /72

This day commence with a moderate breeze from the N.E. steering by the wind under all sail. (Mer Log shall it about the same does not seem to gain much as yet). Mid part steering the same. Latter part fresh breeze ship leading N.W. by N. under all sail. Saw a sail.

Lat 4. 37 Long 25. 27
1088th Feb Mon 26th /72

This commence the same. Mid part steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack. Latter part the same.

Lat 3. 18 Feb Tue 27th /72

This day commence with fresh trade steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack. Saw a sail at 3 1/2 o'clock. Spoke and gained the Cray Fish. Mid part moderate breeze from the N.N.E. steering by the wind under all sail. Latter part moderate breeze from the N.N.E. steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack. Cray Fish & a Merchantman in sight.

Lat 6. 06 North Long 26. 56

This day commence with a moderate breeze from the N.E. steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack. Mid part moderate breeze from the N.E. steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack. Latter part light breeze from the N.E. steering the same.

This day commence with a fresh breeze from the N.E. steering by the wind on the Starboard tack under all sail. Saw a Steamer bound to the S.E. Mid part steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack heading N.W. Latter part fresh breeze from the N.E. steering by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack. Broke out water & Name repaired the Gentle Butt.

Lat 7. 30 Long 29. 23
1092nd March Friday 1st /72

This day commence with a fresh breeze from the N.E. ship heading N. under all sail. Mid part the same. Latter part fresh breeze from the N.E. steering by the wind on the Starboard tack. took in the top gallant sails & Sniffen up - must stay sail. Broke out the oil between decks in order to cooper it.

Lat 8. 28 Long 30. 12
1093rd March Sat 2nd /72

This day commence with fresh trade. Stowed the potato bin in the fore hold at sundown set the drum top of sail. Mid part steering by the wind on the Starboard tack. Latter part the same. Lat 9. 35 Long
