

Remarks on Board Bk Globe A. A. Tripp

1094<sup>th</sup> day

March Sun 3<sup>rd</sup>/72

This day commences with fresh trade steering by the wind under all sail gaining with the Aray Staff at sundown took in the main top-gallant sail & Mizzen top-mast stay sail Meid part the same latter part strong trade heading N N W under all sail (saw grampuses)

Long 31.43

1095<sup>th</sup>

March Mon 4<sup>th</sup>

This day commences with strong trade ship heading N N W by the wind on the starboard tack. Bk Aray Staff in sight at sundown took in the top top sail Meid part trade rather unsteady ship heading from N N W to N under all sail. Latter part fresh trade ship heading the same

1096<sup>th</sup>

March Tues 5<sup>th</sup>/72

This day commences with strong trade ship heading N by W under all sail at sundown took in the main top-gallant sail & Mizzen top-mast stay-sail Meid part strong trade took in the flying jib latter part strong trade steering by the wind under whole top sail course jib & spanker. Lat 12.55, Long 33.29

1097<sup>th</sup>

March Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup>/72

This day commences with strong trade at sundown double reefed the top sails Meid part ship on the starboard tack with strong trade latter part the same (broke out holes) A. Staff in sight Lat 13.54 Long 34.03

Master. Cruising in the N. E Trade Winds

1098<sup>th</sup>

March Thurs 7<sup>th</sup>/72

This day commences with strong trade ship on the starboard tack at 4 o'clock took in the main sail. Saw porpoises Meid part strong trade. Latter part the same steering N N W by N under top sail fore sail main spinnaker and fore top mast stay sail Lat 14.48, Long 34.56

Lat 14.30

1099<sup>th</sup>

March Friday 8<sup>th</sup>/72

This day commences with strong trade steering to the N N W took the Bow & Waist Boards up on the upper orange (saw a large turtle) At sundown wore ship. Meid part steering by the wind on the Port-tack. Latter part steering to the N N W. Aray Staff in sight

1100<sup>th</sup>

March Sat 9<sup>th</sup>/72

This day commences with strong trade steering N N W by W under double reefed top sails fore sail at sundown luffed to the wind on the starboard tack Meid part strong trade latter part moderate trade steering to the S W set the jib & main sail Long 33.42

1101<sup>th</sup>

Lat 14.30

March Sun 10<sup>th</sup>/72

This day commences with moderate trade steering to the S W at 3 o'clock spoke and gained the Aray Staff at sundown took in the jib & main sail. Meid part strong trade latter part strong trade steering to the S W under double reefed top sails fore sail & jib. Aray Staff in sight. Saw a school of porpoises
