7702nd day Mon March 11th/72
This day commences with strong
trade ship heading N. by the wind on
the Starboard tack. Orray Gaff in sight
at Sundown took in jib & main sail
Mid part the same. Leatter part strong trade steering
by the wind on the Starboard tack ~~set~~ the jib and
main-sail. rewhipped the reef points to the main
topsail Lat 14 10 Long 35 31

1103rd Tues March 12th/72
This day commences the same. wore ship
heading S. E. on the Port tack. set hold. broke out
water molasses & vinegar at Sundown took in the
jib & main-sail Mid part steering by the wind
on the Port tack Leatter part moderate breeze
steering by the wind on the Starboard tack
set the jib main sail & Mizzen top mast stay sail
Saw 3 sails. Lat 14 06 Long 35 57

1104th Wednes March 13th/72
This day commences the same at
Sundown took in the light sails. Saw a merchant
brig heading to the Northward. Mid part
steering with the O. Gaff Leatter part moderate
breeze ship on different tack set the main sail &
flying jib Lat 14 05 Long 36 05

1105th Thurs March 14th/72
This day commences the same turned
reef out steering by the wind on the Starboard
tack at Sundown took in the light sails & reefed
the topsails Mid part moderate breeze ship on
the ~~Starboard~~ Port tack Leatter part moderate breeze
Ship at 7 o'clock heading S. E. made all sail. Orray Gaff
in sight also a merchantman (Brig)

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1106th Friday March 15th/72
This day commences with fine weather
Ship on the Port tack under all sail. Broke out
Beef at Sundown shortened sail as usual Mid
part the same Leatter part fresh breeze steering
by the wind under all sail on the Starboard tack
sent down the fore-sail for repair. Orray Gaff
in sight.

1107th day Sat March 16th/72
This day commences with fresh trade
steering by the wind on the Starboard tack under
all sail finished repairing the fore sail & kept
at Sundown Orray Gaff went aboard the Orray Gaff
at Sundown took in the light sails and double
reefed the top sails Mid part fresh breeze ship
heading N. E. by the wind on the Starboard tack
Saw a merchantman heading to the Southward
Leatter part moderate trade steering by the
wind on the Starboard tack Orray Gaff in sight
Lat 14 46 Long 36 46

1108th Sun March 17th/72
This day commences with moderate trade
steering to the S & W set the reef out. at Sundown
luffed to the wind on the Port tack. Mid part
moderate trade ship on the Port tack Leatter
part steering by the wind on the Starboard tack
Lat 14 42 Long 37 02

1109th Mon March 18th/1872
This day commences with fresh trade
steering by the wind on the Port tack. Broke out
water Saw a school of Black fish and caught
one in each Boat Starboard & Waist Boat. Orray
Gaff Boats also lowered but caught none
