1117th March Tue 26th/72
This day commences with moderate
trade steering by the wind under reefed
topsails course jib and Spanker the Oray
Craft and a Merchantman in sight
at Sundown look on the main-dail
Mid part fine weather Leather part moderate
trade Ship on the Port tack under all sail
Oray Craft and Schooner in sight

1118th March 27th/72
This day commences with moderate
trade steering by the wind on the
Starboard tack. Spoke the Schooner
Demickstep Captⁿ Birch of Provincetown
10 month out with 236 bbls Sperm at
Sundown look on the light dail & double
reefed Captⁿ Howland of the Oray Craft
came aboard Mid part fine weather
broke up the game at 70 o'clock Leather
part light trade steering by the wind under
all sail Saw a School Black fish Coured 3
Boats and obtained one the Starboard Boat
Oray Craft lowered 2 Boats also
Lat 14. 14 Long 37. 30

1119th March Thursday 28th
This day commences with light trade steering
by the wind under all sail on the Starboard
tack watch employed in heaving out Water
& Leaning the Black fish blubber at Sundown
look on the light dails & hauled the maindail up
Mid part fine weather Leather part the same steering by
the wind on the Starboard tack under all sail ^{obtained the blubber}
Lat 14. 50 Long 37. 17

1120th March Friday 29th/72
This day commences with light trade
steering by the wind on the Port tack under
all sail. Oray Craft on Sight at Sundown
Shortened sail to double reefed top Sails fore
dail jib & Spanker Mid part moderate trade
steering by the wind on the Port tack
Leather part fresh trade steering by the
wind on the Starboard tack. boiled out the
Black fish blubber turned up 2 bbls (~~set~~ the
wife out)

1121th March Sat 30th/72
This day commences the same
packed ship at 4 o'clock. Oray Craft
at Sundown double reefed the top dail & under
the main dail Mid part strong trade
steering by the wind under double reefed
top dail & fore dail look on the jib & Spanker
Leather part strong trade steering by the
wind under the same sail Oray Craft
& the Demickstep in sight
Lat 14. 34 Long 37. 18

1122nd March Sun 31st
This day commences with strong trade
steering S.W. Saw a Merchantman heading
to the N. at Sundown luffed to the wind on
the Port tack Mid part steering by the
wind on the Port tack. Leather part strong
trade ship on the Port tack. set the jib &
Spanker Saw a school of Black fish
caught 2 dolphins. Oh dear my one I wish
that this voyage would end for I am
about tired of this fun Lat 13. 50. Long 37. 10
