1123rd

April Mon 1st/72

This April fool day commences with moderate trades steering by the wind on the Starboard tack set the main-dail Aray Mast in sight at Sundown took in the main-dail Mead part moderate breeze steering by the wind under double reefed top-sails fore-dail jib and Spanker Leatter part moderate breeze from the N.E steering by the wind under all sail on the Port tack at 6 o'clock raised a school of Black-fish lowered 3 Boats and chased them until they sweet Boats came aboard at 7 o'clock with no fish broke out Beef Mollasse & Water & lost hold

1124th

April Tues 2nd/72

This day commences with moderate trades ship by the wind on the same tack under all sail at Sundown took in the light sails gamed the Aray Mast saw the Schooner sailing to the windward Meid part moderate breeze Leatter part the same made all sail one ship at 6 1/2 o'clock steering by the wind on the Starboard tack watch employed in seizing on the Bunt gaskets Lat 14.01 Long 37.08

1125th

April Wednes 3rd/72

This day commences with fine weather ship by the wind on the Starboard tack at Sundown took in the light sails Meid part moderate breeze Leatter part the same made all sail steering by the wind on the Starboard tack O. Top in sight

April Thurs 4th/72

This day commences with moderate trades steering by the wind on the Starboard tack under all sail broke out all the wood that could be found in the lower hold find that we are rather short of wood at 5 o'clock gamed the Aray Mast Meid part gaming with fine weather Leatter part steering S.W. under all sail Cooper employed in finishing off the new Buckets Lat 13.57 Long 37.36

1127th

April Friday 5th/72

This day commences with moderate trades steering to the S.W. Aray Mast in sight at Sundown took in the light sails and hauled up the main-sail and luffed to the wind on the Port tack Meid part fresh trades steering by the wind on the Port tack Leatter part fresh trades steering to the N.W. under whole top sails fore-dail jib & Mizzen topmast stay dail at 7 o'clock lowered for Blackfish but did not get any broke out Water

1128th

April Sat 6th/72

This day commences with fresh trades steering to the N.W. gamed the Aray Mast at Sundown double reefed & took in the light sails and luffed to the wind on the Starboard tack Meid part moderate breeze ship heading to the N.W. set the reefs out Leatter part the same watch employed in putting new buckets into the new Buckets Lat 13.32 Long 38.15
