

Continued Remarks On Board

1144th April Mon 22nd/12
This day commences with moderate
trade steering W. N. W. under top-sail &
main top - gallant sail. Saw a sail heading
to the S. W. Saw a school of Black-fish
hauled 3 Boats and obtained none. Struck
one but drew from him at sundown double
reefed & took in the main top-sail.
Made part fine weather Latter part the same
steering W. N. W. under double reefed top-sail
& fore-sail employed in tarring down the
rigging. finished painting the rigging.
Lat 14.30. Long 59.40

1145th April Tues 23rd/12
This day commences with moderate
trade steering W. N. W. employed in tarring
and painting. painted the jib & fly jib boom
also Spirit-sail yard &c painted the gun
Buckets. Made part steering W. N. W.
Latter part moderate trade steering to the N. W.
employed in tarring the fore & top stays.
painted forward house (over head) and painted
the beam & dead eye. broke out bread.
Lat 15.27 Long 50.40

April Wednes 24th/12
1146th This day commences the same painted
the Mast Boat. Made part steering W. N. W.
Latter part steering W. by N set the reef out of the
main top-sail painted the mizen mast & Mast
Boat.
Lat 15.45 Long 52.15

Bk Globe Through The N.E. trades

1147th April Thurs 25th/12
This day commences with moderate
trade steering W. by N employed in tarring
down the fore & main top mast rigging also
tanned the Starboard main rigging. Maintained the
head of the fore mast. Made part steering
the same. Latter part steering N. W. by W
under whole main top sail & double reefed
fore top sail. employed in painting the fore
mast & fore top mast head & cross tree also
painted the Quarter Boats. Saw a Whig
heading to the Westward.
Lat 16.20 Long 53.59

1148th April Friday 26th/12
This day commences with moderate trade
steering the same painted the main mast
and Boat kegs & line tubs also the buckets
burned up oil & set the main top gallant
sail & jibs and hauled to the N. W. by N
Saw a school of porpoises. Made part fine
weather. Latter part moderate trade steering
N. W. by N made all sail employed in
painting chests also painting aloft. finished
painting aloft washed the ship outside as
far as the waist broke out water & flour
(Her Eggshell off duty on account of sickness).

1149th April Sat 27th/12
This day commences with a light air
from the Northward braced up steering by the
wind on the Starboard tack sent the Sprinker
and set the fore top-sail. Made part steering
the same. Latter part light trade steering N. W.
under all sail employed in painting ship outside. in sight
Lat 17.37 Long 55.15
