breeze from NW heading NW and NW

Monday 2 light breeze from NW
heading SW saw 4 sails so end
Lat 34 44 Long 40 23 Bate. 03 03 8

the
Tuesday 3 light breeze from NW
heading NW saw 4 sails
Lat 34 25 Long 40 50 Bate. 03 04 8

the
Wednesday 4 strong breeze from
NW heading NW so end
Lat 34 15 Long 41 47 Bate. 03 06

the
Thursday 5 strong breeze from
E heading N and NW goat out
beef so end
Lat 33 54 Long 42 39 Bate. 03 07 8

Friday 6 strong breeze from E steering
SW and N saw 3 sails so end
