Saturday 21 strong breeze from
E N E steering different courses
saw nothing so ends

the
Sunday 22 light breeze from
S tacked and retacked same 2 sails
Lat 35 06 Long 39 32 Date 103 278

the
Monday 23 strong breeze from E N E
tacked and retacked same one sail
Lat 35 15 Long 38 53 Date 103 288

the
Tuesday 24 strong breeze and squally
from S E tacked and retacked
and retacked saw whales and
lowerd but got none at sundown
came on board so ends
Lat 35 10 Long 38 40 Date 103 30

the
Wednesday 25 calm at 6 A M saw
whales and lowerd and got
one made four barrels at 4 P M
saw whales lowerd but got none
Lat 35 09 Long 38 37 Date 103 318

the
Thursday 26 calm at 6 A M saw
whales did not lower so ends
Lat 35 09 Long 38 30 Date 103 328

the
Friday 27 light air from S S W
heading W at 11 A M saw whales
and lowerd and got two and
took them to the ship so ends
Lat 35 18 Long 38 34 Date 103 338

the
Saturday 28 light breeze from S S E
employed cutting at 7 A M finished
cutting and braced full heading S S E
Lat 35 28 Long 38 10 Date 103 348

the
Sunday 29 light breeze from S S W
heading W and W S W and S S E
at 7 A M finished bylines so ends
Lat 35 28 Long 38 35 Date 103 36

the
Monday 30 strong breeze from S W by
W heading S S E saw nothing so ends
Lat 35 12 Long 37 40 Date 103 378

the
Tuesday 31 strong breeze from S W by
W heading S S E and W by W with
rain saw 9 sails employed stowing
down so ends at 4 P M saw
whales jaying to the windward
specie did not lower
Lat 35 28 Long 38 41 Date 103 388

the
Wednesday 1 strong breeze from W S W
tacked and retacked same 9 sails
spoke the spar tower so ends
Lat 35 23 Long 38 44 Date 103 398

the
Thursday 2 light breeze from W S W
and W tacked and retacked
saw two sails so ends
Lat 35 18 Long 38 48 Date 103 408

the
Friday 3 light breeze from W tacked
and retacked same 9 sails so ends
Lat 35 04 Long 39 27 Date 103 418
