heading E. & S. saw 3 sails

Friday 7 light airs and calm
heading E. & S. saw 3 sails so ends
Lat 32 00 Long 57 31 Date 21 00

the
Saturday 8 strong breeze from SE
heading E. & S. saw nothing
Lat 32 00 Long 55 37 Date 21 04

the
Sunday 9 strong breeze from S
heading E. & S. saw nothing
Lat 31 37 Long 53 15 Date 21 08

the
Monday 10 strong breeze from
S. & W. saw 2 sails heading SE
so ends
Lat 31 02 Long 50 58 Date 21 12

the
Tuesday 11 light breeze from
W. & S. saw one sail so ends
Lat 30 58 Long 49 44 Date 21 16

craft about 15 miles out
650 barrels sperm

W. & S. saw ship to S. S. W. saw
one sail so ends
Lat 31 35 Long 50 10 Date 21 20

Thursday 13 light breeze from
W. heading S. & W. saw
Lat 30 47 Long 50 00 Date 21 24

the
Friday 14 light breeze from
S. & W. steering before wind so ends
Lat 31 15 Long 44 56 Date 21 28

the
Saturday 15 light breeze from W. steering
E. and S. & W. spoke the bark
Pioneer capt. down in morning
Lat 31 43 Long 49 24 Date 21 32

the
Sunday 16 light breeze from
W. & S. heading W. at 6 AM
4 or 5 whales (hales) cornered
and started at one did not
get fast the harrier got true
Lat 31 35 Long 49 08 Date 21 36

the
Monday 17 light breeze from
W. & S. heading W. at 6 AM
saw whales cornered and chased
until 4 PM came on board
the whales in sight the harrier
spoke one so ends
Lat 31 53 Long 49 48 Date 21 40

Tuesday 18 light breeze from W. & S.
heading W. & S. saw nothing
Lat 32 05 Long 49 45 Date 21 44
