First part of these 24 hours fresh breezes from the WNW with fine weather veered ship to the North at 8 Pm wind hauled to the North steered ship W by South along with the Land Middle part the same the Bell of Portland light bearing NE 25 miles distance at 6 Am wind hauled to the West ship heading on a wind to the SSW Latter part pleasant working ship to the West under all sail

Remarks On Board Thursday ~~April~~ May 1st

First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from WSW with fine weather ship heading on a wind to the NNE at 8 Pm light airs at 9 gentle breeze from SSW with fine weather Middle part the same start point light bearing NNE 20 miles distance at 1 Pm strong breezes with rain at 6 gentle gales from East rain and a bad sea on hauled up courses and double reefed the topsails took Anchors on the Bows unshent chains &c Latter part more moderate steering ship West,

Remarks On Board Friday May 2^d

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from East and rugged at 3 Pm more moderate let reefs out the top sail set main top gallant sail steering ship West Middle part calm at 3 Pm light breeze from East Latter part strong breeze from East steering W by S under all sail,

Remarks On Board Saturday May 3^d 1856

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from East with pleasant weather steering ship W by S Middle part the same Latter part wind from SE steering W by S under all sail, employed in ships duty

Remarks On Board Sunday May 4th

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from SE with pleasant weather Middle part gentle gales with bad weather doubled reefed top sails and furled main sail at 6 Am wind hauled to the West Latter part strong breeze ship heading on a wind to N by W under doubled reefs

Remarks On Board Monday May 5th

First part of these 24 hours fresh breezes from West and rugged Middle & Latter parts the same ship on different tacks working to the West under double reefed top sails and courses so on
