

Remarks On Board Thursday May 15th 1856

First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from S.W. with fine weather at 3 PM saw the Islands of St George and Pico the S.W. 25 miles distance steering ship for Fioll at 4 PM saw the Island to the West 30 miles distance. Middle part gentle breezes with pleasant weather ship lying aback 15 miles to N.E. of Fioll at 4 PM kept ship off for the Town on Fioll at 9 PM landed boat Capt Austin went on shore latter part light air and pleasant ship lying off and on between Fioll and Pico

Remarks On Board Friday May 16th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from N.E. with fine weather ship lying off and on between Fioll and Pico at 6 PM the Captain came on board with boat and crew with recruits. Middle part light air and pleasant ship lying off and on at 9 PM Captain went on shore. Latter part light winds and pleasant ship lying off and on

Remarks On Board Saturday May 17th

First part of these 24 hours light air from N.E. with fine weather ship lying off and on at 6 PM Capt Austin came board shipped one boatsteerer kept ship of S.W. Middle part light air from S.W. steering ship S.W. by S. Latter part light winds from S.W. by S ship heading on a wind to the S.E. under all sail Pico in sight to S.W. 45 miles distance

Lat of Obs 33° 55' N

Remarks On Board Sunday May 18th 1856

First part of these 24 hours light winds from S.W. with fine weather at 6 PM veered ship to the West; Middle & Latter parts strong breezes from South ship heading on a wind to S.W. under Top sails and Courses Lat by Account 33° 50' N Long by Obs 29° 30' W

Remarks On Board Monday May 19th

First part of these 24 hours fresh breezes from South and cloudy ship heading on a wind to the S.W. Middle part calm at 10 AM saw a piece of a wreck vessel, land a boat and found it to be a part of an upper deck. Latter part light air from North steering S.W.

Remarks On Board Tuesday May 20th

First part of these 24 hours light winds from North with fine weather Middle & Latter parts the same steering ship South by West under all sail

Long by Obs 29° 10' W

Remarks On Board Wednesday May 21st

First part of these 24 hours light winds from North with fine weather Middle & Latter parts light winds with fine weather steering ship South under all sail

Lat of Obs 33° 35' N

Long of Obs 29° 10' W
