

Remarks On Board Saturday May 31st 1856

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from NE and pleasant steering Ship S by W at 6 PM took in fore & main. Top gallant Sails and Fly. Middle part pleasant at 1 PM let Ship come too on a wind with head yards aback at 4 PM steered Ship off South at 6 PM the Isle of Sol bearing ESE 20 miles distance at 9 PM saw the Island of Bonavesta bearing SE 20 miles distance latter part gentle breeze steering Ship SSE for St. Agos saw on sail to the East

Remarks On Board Sunday June 1st

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from NE with pleasant weather steering Ship SSE at 3 PM saw Lintains Rocks bearing South 15 miles distance at 6 PM took in Top Gallant Sails and Fly. Middle at 8 let Ship come too on a wind with head yards aback. Middle part gentle breeze and pleasant Ship lying aback at daylight kept Ship off SSE for St. Agos at 6 PM saw the Island a head 15 miles distance latter part gentle breeze steering Ship for Port Praya

Lat Obs 14.18 N

Remarks On Board Monday June 2^d

First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze at 3 PM Ship being off Port Praya let Ship come to on a wind heading off shore. Middle part fresh breeze and pleasant Ship lying off and on at 8 PM Capt Austin went on shore with one boat and crew. Latter part gentle breeze with fine weather Ship lying off and on at Port Praya

Remarks On Board Tuesday June 3^d

First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from NE with fine weather at 6 PM Captaining and crew came on board with recruits kept Ship off to SE for the Island of Bravo, Middle part calm. Latter part gentle breeze from NE with pleasant weather Ship between St. Agos and Gogo heading to NE for Bravo,

Remarks On Board Wednesday June 4th

First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from NE at 1 PM saw the Island of Bravo to SE steered Ship off to SE at 4 PM let Ship come too on a wind heading to the East with head yards aback to windward of Bravo, Middle and latter parts fresh breeze with clear weather Ship lying off and on at Bravo the Captaining with one boat on shore after recruits

Remarks On Board Thursday June 5th

First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze and clear weather Ship lying off and on 6 PM got all the recruits on board Capt came on board steered Ship off S by E under all sail. Middle & latter parts gentle breeze with fine weather steering Ship S by E under all sail
