First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from the South with fine weather ship heading on a wind to the WSW under all sail Middle & latter parts the same several Sails in sight

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from SSW with fine weather Middle & latter parts the same ship heading on a wind to the SW under all sail
 Lat Obs 0.11 N

Remarks On Board Friday June 20th

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from SB with squally weather Middle & latter parts the same ship heading on a wind to the SSW under all sail

Remarks On Board Saturday June 21st 1856

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from SB with squally weather took in Top Gallant Sails and Fly Gibb at 4 PM unrigged reef the Top Sails Middle and latter parts the same ship heading on a wind to SSW under all sail

Remarks On Board Sunday June 22nd

First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from SB with squally weather Middle part the same at 9 AM found the heel of the Main Top Mast squashed up it being rotten in the fid hole latter part strong breeze and pleasant
