First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from the North with fine weather Middle part the same Latter part strong breezes with thick and rainy weather steering South under short sail employed in sending down the Fore & Mizens Top Gallant Masts,

First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from the North with rain Middle & Latter parts fine weather steering Ship to the south under short sail employed in moving the two after tanks forward

Remarks On Board Saturday July 5th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from the North with fine weather Middle & Latter parts the same steering Ship SSW under short sail employed in stowing up betwixt Decks,

First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from the North with pleasant weather Middle part the same Latter part strong breezes and cloudy weather steering Ship South by East

Remarks On Board Monday July 7th 1856

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from North with hazy weather at 4 PM doubled reefed the Top Sails Middle part gentle gales with rain at 4 AM strong gales took in fore & mizen Top Sails and fore sail let Ship come to on a mind heading to the East Latter part strong gales from NWSW with a bad sea on Ship lying too under a close reefed main Top Sail,

Remarks On Board Tuesday July 8th

First part of these 24 hours fresh gales from the NW with a bad sea on Middle part the same Ship lying too at 4 AM more moderate kept Ship off S S under top sails and main top Gallant Sail Latter part strong breezes and squally

Remarks On Board Wednesday July 9th

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from the NWSW with a bad swell on found the spanker boom rotten took it in to repair Middle and latter part strong breezes with squally weather steering S S E,

First part of these 24 hours gentle gales from NWSW with squally weather Middle & Latter parts the same steering Ship S S E under top sails and main top Gallant Sail
