

Remarks On Board Saturday August 16th 1856

First part of these 24 hours gentle gale from SSW with thick rainy weather could not see any thing of the Horn Boat at 2 PM the other two boats came on board, and saw no boat ship cruising off the place where the boat was last seen at 4 PM kept ship off along shore to the East of the Island and ran down to lee side of the Island saw no boat but ship by two under a close reefed main top sail and reefed fore sail heading to SW Middle part gentle gales ship lying under short sail heading to West, latter part the same.

Remarks On Board Sunday August 17th

First part of these 24 hours fresh gale from SSW and rugged ship heading to the West under a close reefed main top sail and fore sail at 11 PM wind backed to WNW and veered ship to the North and set close reefed top sails and jib latter part gentle gales and clear weather ship heading on a wind to the North under doubled reefs.

Remarks On Board Monday August 18th

First part of these 24 hours gentle gale from SSW and rugged ship heading on a wind to the North under doubled reefs at 5 PM saw Gaufr Island bearing East 30 miles distance Middle part ship lying aback at 7 PM kept ship off fore the Island and ran down under the lee spoke ship Catherine of New London with the Horn Boat and saw the boat having cut from the whale, it blowing hard at the time she went on board, latter part fresh gale and clear ship to the east of the Island under short sail

Remarks On Board Tuesday August 19th 1856

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from West and rugged middle part more moderate at 7 AM boats went in shore latter part gentle breezes and pleasant ship to the East of the Island 3 boats in shore saw several right whales but did not get fast,

Remarks On Board Wednesday August 20th

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from SSW and rugged at 4 AM boats came on board Middle part gentle breezes at 7 AM 3 boats went in shore latter part strong breezes and squally ship to the East of Gaufr Island lying off and on saw three whales in shore but could not get fast,

Remarks On Board Thursday August 21st

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from SSW and rugged at 3 PM boats came on board Middle part rainy at 9 AM cleared up 3 boats went in shore latter part strong breezes and pleasant saw several whales, could not get fast,

Remarks On Board Friday August 22nd

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from SSW at 3 PM boats came on board Middle part strong breezes and thick drizzly weather at 8 AM 3 boats went in shore it came on a gale came on board again latter part strong gale from North ship to the South of the Island under close reefs heading to the West,
