

Remarks On Board Monday September 8th 1856

First part of these 24 hours gentle gale from West and squally Middle & latter parts the same Ship lying off and on to the North of Gaupe Island with three boats in shore cruising for Whales

Remarks On Board Tuesday September 9th

First part of these 24 hours gentle gale from West and squally Middle part the same latter part strong breeze from South with squally weather Ship to N.E. of Gaupe Island with two boats in shore cruising for Whales.

Remarks On Board Wednesday September 10th

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from South with clear weather at 3 PM the two boats came on board from shore saw a few Whales but could not get fast. Middle part light air from S.S.W. with fine weather at 6 AM the boats went in shore to take off the stores boat & on board. Latter part light air Ship to the East of Gaupe Island 8 miles distance boats all came on board &c.

Remarks On Board Thursday September 11th

First part of these 24 hours light air and variable Middle part the same at 7 AM three boats went in shore Latter part gentle gale from West and squally boats came on board saw one Whale only Ship lying to N.E. of Gaupe Island

Remarks On Board Friday September 12th 1856

First part of these 24 hours strong gale from S.W. with squalls at 4 PM steered Ship off to N.W. under doubled reefed Top Sails and reefed courses for Tristan Islands. Middle part strong gale with heavy squalls split main Topmast stay-sail took in Jib & reefed Top Sails Latter part gentle gale from S.S.W. steering N.W. by W under doubled reefs
Lat of Anson 39.30 S
Long of Dr. 11.35 W

Remarks On Board Saturday September 13th

First part of these 24 hours gentle gale from S.W. and squally steering Ship N.W. by N Middle part gentle gale and clear weather at 4 PM saw Tristan Island bearing North 50 miles distance Latter part cloudy and hazy weather Ship lying under short sail heading to N.W.W
Lat of Ob 38.01 S
Long of Dr. 12.15 W

Remarks On Board Sunday September 14th

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from N.W.W. with cloudy weather steering Ship S.E. at 3 PM saw Sightingale Island bearing North 15 miles distance Middle part fresh breeze and pleasant weather Ship lying aback most of the time in between the Islands saw one Ship to S.W. Latter part strong breeze Ship lying off and on at the North of Tristan Island with one boat a shore
