

Remarks On Board Thursday October 9th 1846

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from South with fine weather ship heading on a wind to S by E saw the Cape of Good Hope bearing NNE 25 miles distance at 11 PM veered ship to SSE middle part pleasant weather at 3 AM veered ship to S by E latter part fine weather ship heading on a wind to S by E under all sail saw Cape Agulhas bearing NE 3 miles distance
Lat 3° 06' S 34.06 S

Remarks On Board Friday October 10th

First part of these 24 hours light winds from South with fine weather middle and latter parts light air and calm with fine weather ship heading on a wind to SSE under all sail saw the Land to the North 30 miles distance
Lat 4° 06' S 34.58 S

Remarks On Board Saturday October 11th

First part of these 24 hours light winds from South with fine weather ship heading on a wind to the S by E saw two ships heading West middle and latter parts strong breeze from SSE ship heading on a wind to S by E under all sail,
Lat by Obs 36.01 S

Remarks On Board Sunday October 12th

First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from SSE with fine weather middle part the same latter part light winds from South and misty ship heading on a wind to SSE under all sail saw a Sulphur bottom covered boat without success

Remarks On Board Monday October 13th 1846

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze and variable middle part the same latter part gentle breeze from West with fine weather steering ship SSE under all sail saw a ship's Foremast carried away by the Deck took it along side of the ship and hoisted it on board

Remarks On Board Tuesday October 14th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from West with fine weather middle part the same latter part strong breeze from NNE with clear weather steering ship SSE under all sail

Lat Obs 36.20 S
Long Obs 27.00 E

Remarks On Board Wednesday October 15th

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from NNE with rugged weather middle part the same latter part strong breeze from NNE and squally steering ship SSE under all sail

Lat 4° 06' S 36.06 S
Long Obs 31.15 E

Remarks On Board Thursday October 16th

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from SW and rugged middle part squally doubled reef the Top Sails latter strong breeze from SSE and rugged steering ship SSE under Top Sails and main Top Gallant Sails
