First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from N.W. with rugged weather Middle & latter parts strong breeze with thick heavy weather Ship on different tack cruising

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from North and rainy Middle part the same latter part strong breeze from S.E. and rugged Ship on different tack cruising

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from S.E. and rugged saw several fine backs spoke Barques Isabel and Cherokee of New Bedford Middle and latter parts light air and variable Ship on different tack cruising, Lat Ob. 34.21 S

First part of these 24 hours light air and variable Middle part the same latter part gentle breeze from N.W. with fine weather Ship on different tack cruising

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from North and rugged Middle and latter parts the same saw one Right Whale and two Ship Ship on different tack cruising under double reefs

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from N.W. and rugged with thick heavy weather saw one Right Whale lured boat without success Middle part rainy latter part gentle breeze with pleasant weather Ship cruising
