First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from
NW with pleasant weather Middle and latter
parts the same steering Ship on different
courses - cruising one ship in sight setting
English Boilers Lat of Ob 34:10 S

Remarks On Board Monday November 24th
First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from
West Middle part the same spoke Ship
Minerva Smith of New Bedford latter part
gentle breeze from West and pleasant steering
Ship to the East employed in stowing oil
in the main hold,

Remarks On Board Tuesday November 25th
First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from
West and pleasant Middle and latter parts light
air and variable steering Ship East,

Remarks On Board Wednesday November 26th
First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from
West with fine weather Middle and latter
parts the same ship on different courses
cruising Lat of Ob 34:41 S

Long Orho 69:45 E

Remarks On Board Thursday November 27th
First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze
with squalls Middle part light air and variable
latter part strong breeze from SW ship heading
to SE Lat of Ob 35:06 S

Long Orho 71:15 E

Remarks On Board Friday November 28th 1856

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from
West Middle and latter parts the same
working Ship to West on different courses
saw two Merchant Ships steering to NE
Lat of Ob 34:37 S

Remarks On Board Saturday November 29th
First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from
West with pleasant weather Middle part light
air at 11 AM saw several fin back'd h'd
boats shot one of them with a Bombarce killed
the whale and it sunk. latter part calm
with fog

Remarks On Board Sunday November 30th
First part of these 24 hours light air and variable
Middle part the same latter part gentle
breeze from NW with fine weather steering
Ship West under all sail saw a ship
steering to the East Lat of Ob 34:19 S
Long Orho 69:00 E

Remarks On Board Monday December 1st
First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze
from NW with fine weather Middle part
the same at 7 AM it being thick and hazy
saw a Right Whale close to the ship killed him
latter part wind from West with thick and
rainy weather
