First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from SSW and squally at 6 PM heavy squalls of wind closed reef Top Sails Middle and latter parts gentle gales from SSW and reeoped Ship under short sail

Remarks On Board Friday December 12th

First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from South Middle and latter parts light airs and variable with pleasant weather one sail in sight Lat of Obs 34.22 S

Remarks On Board Saturday December 13

First part of these 24 hours light winds from SSW with pleasant weather Middle and latter parts the same spoke Barque Memmouth of Cold Spring

Remarks On Board Sunday December 14th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from SSW Middle and latter parts the same with fine weather steering Ship SSB under all sail

Remarks On Board Monday December 15th

First part of these 24 hours light winds from SSW with fine weather Middle and latter parts the same steering Ship SSB under all sail

Lat of Obs 37.01 S

Remarks On Board Tuesday December 16th 1846

First part of these 24 hours light winds from South with pleasant weather Middle and latter parts light airs from NNE with pleasant weather Ship heading to SSB employed in bending sails Lat of Obs 37.22 S

Remarks On Board Wednesday December 17th

First part of these 24 hours light winds from NE with fine weather Middle and latter parts the same steering Ship SSB under all sail saw a whale Ship steering to South

Remarks On Board Thursday December 18th

First part of these 24 hours light winds from NE with fine weather Middle and latter parts the same ship heading on a wind to SSB under all sail Lat of Obs 38.34 S

Long Obs 69.00 E

Remarks On Board Friday December 19th

First part of these 24 hours light airs from East and variable Middle and latter parts the same working Ship to the East one Ship in sight Boiling Lat of Obs 38.11 S

Remarks On Board Saturday December 20th

First part of these 24 hours light airs from East and variable with pleasant weather Middle and latter parts the same working Ship to the East under all sail spoke Ship Coliv court
