

Remarks On Board Tuesday February 3rd 1857

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from North Middle part the same latter part more moderate saw several Right Whales loved boats without success employed in killing

Remarks On Board Wednesday February 4th
First part of these 24 hours fresh breezes from North saw several Right Whales at 4 PM fastened to one Laid and took it to ship commenced cutting at 10 finished cutting the Whale Middle and latter parts gentle gales and rugged ship under short sail,

Long Do. 70.20 E

Remarks On Board Thursday February 5th
First part of these 24 hours gentle gales from SSW and rugged Middle and latter parts strong gales with squally weather ship lying too under short sail

Remarks On Board Friday February 6th
First part of these 24 hours fresh gales from SSW with squally weather Middle and latter parts more moderate ship under short sail employed in killing

Remarks On Board Saturday February 7th
First part of these 24 hours fresh gales from West and rugged Middle and latter parts the same ship lying too under short sail,

Remarks On Board Sunday February 8th 1857

First part of these 24 hours fresh gales from West and rugged Middle part the same latter part gentle gales from SSW ship under short sail employed in killing

Remarks On Board Monday February 9th
First part of these 24 hours gentle gales from SSW Middle part the same at 8 AM spoke ship Mamasan Smith of New Bedford having her head carried away and her head ends started by a sea, latter part strong breezes with rugged weather finished killing employed in storing oil in main hatch

Remarks On Board Tuesday February 10th
First part of these 24 hours strong breezes and variable Middle and latter parts foggy ship under short sail employed in storing oil in main hatch,

Remarks On Board Wednesday February 11th
First part of these 24 hours gentle gales from West Middle and latter parts light winds from SSW with thick and foggy most of the time

Remarks On Board Thursday February 12th
First part of these 24 hours light airs and calm with thick weather Middle and latter parts the same
