First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from SSW with thick and foggy Middle and latter parts light air and variable with fine weather Ship on different tack

First part of these 24 hours light air and variable Middle part the same latter part gentle breeze from North with pleasant weather steering Ship different courses cruising

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from North with thick and rainy weather Middle part foggy at 6 AM saw a Right Whale lured boat without success at 9 AM saw several Whales lured boats the Bow boat fastened to one the iron hook lost the whale latter part strong breeze from West and cloudy and hazy weather several ships in sight

Remarks On Board Tuesday February 17th 1857

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from West with thick. Drizzly part of the time Middle and latter parts gentle gales and rugged Ship under short sail heading on different tack several ships in sight

Remarks On Board Wednesday February 18th

First part of these 24 hours gentle gales from West and rugged Middle and latter parts strong breeze with rugged weather saw several Right Whales lured boats without success

Remarks On Board Thursday February 19th

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from West with rugged weather saw several Whales lured boats and fastened to one at 4 PM the lines got cut off lost the whale 5 vions 1 Spade 1 Lance Middle and latter parts strong gales and rugged,
