

Remarks On Board Sunday February 22nd 1857

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from West and rugged with thick weather most of the time at 4 P.M. lured boats starboard boat fastened to one the whale ran to windward it being rugged cut line lost the whale Middle and latter part gentle gales with a bad sea on ship under doubled reefs a plenty of whales in sight.

First part of these 24 hours strong gales from West and rugged Middle and latter part strong gales from NW with thick and rainy weather ship under short sail

First part of these 24 hours strong gales from West with a bad sea on Middle part more moderate at 9 A.M. saw several Right whales lured boats in chase the Starboard boat fastened to one the Iron Drained lost the whale latter part light winds with fine weather boats in chase of whales.

First part of these 24 hours light air and variable saw several whales lured boats without success Middle part strong breeze from East and hazy at 7 A.M. saw several whales lured boats Waste boat fastened to one lost the line and whale latter part thick and hazy weather

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from NW with thick and foggy weather Middle and latter part gentle gales with thick and rainy weather Ship under short sail, Lat Hano 48.10 S

First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from North with thick weather at 2 P.M. fog cleared up saw several whales lured boats at 6 P.M. starboard boat fastened to one the Iron Drained lost the whale, Middle part strong breeze with rugged at 9 A.M. saw saw whales lured boats Starboard boat fastened to one held the whale and sunk latter part fresh breeze
