First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from NNE and squally middle and latter parts the same ship lying off and on at St Pauls two boats in shore fishing &c.,

Remarks On Board Wednesday April 1st
First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from West middle and latter parts strong breezes and rugged ship lying off and on at St Pauls

Remarks On Board Thursday April 2nd
First part of these 24 hours light winds and variable with pleasant weather middle and latter parts light winds with fine weather ship lying off and on to SE of St Pauls,

Remarks On Board Friday April 3rd
First part of these 24 hours light winds from NNE with fine weather ship lying off and on at St Pauls at 6 PM steered ship off to SSE under all sail set foremast and top gallant standing sails middle and latter parts fine weather steering ship SSE under all sail

Remarks On Board Saturday April 4th
First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from NNE with fine weather middle and latter parts strong breezes with fine weather steering ship SSE under all sail

Lat of Obs 38.50 S
Long of Obs 83.10 E

Remarks On Board Sunday April 5th 1857

First part of these 24 hours fresh breezes from SSE and squally middle and latter part gentle breezes from SSE with fine weather ship heading on a wind to the East under all sail
Lat of Obs 38.14 S

Remarks On Board Monday April 6th
First part of these 24 hours light winds from SE with fine weather middle and latter parts light winds from East and variable ship on different tasks working to the East employed in storing oil in fore hold,

Remarks On Board Tuesday April 7th
First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from East and variable middle and latter parts the same ship heading on a wind to South under all sail employed in storing oil in fore hold

Remarks On Board Wednesday April 8th
First part of these 24 hours light winds from SE with pleasant weather middle and latter parts light air and variable steering ship SSE under all sail

Remarks On Board Thursday April 9th
First part of these 24 hours light winds from NNE and variable middle and latter parts gentle breezes from North with fine weather steering ship SSE under all sail employed in washing ship
